Several general guidelines are listed below. These should be worked out in detail for the specific situation.

IN THE EVENT OF A FIRE:

1. Report the fire to the emergency number/fire service
2. Report fire immediately to the owner/manager
3. Evacuate yourself and others to a safe place
4. Evacuation plan for the animals present:



IN THE EVENT OF AN ACCIDENT:

1. If present, seek assistance of people with first aid experience
2. Call the emergency number, and provide information to responders
3. Report the accident immediately to the owner/manager



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PRECAUTIONS FOR AN INFECTIOUS ANIMAL DISEASE:

1. There is a sufficient stock of feed during a 72-hour *stand-still*
2. In the event of a transport ban (after consultation with the municipal authorities), emergency housing for at least 6 weeks can be arranged as follows:



POWER OUTAGE

1. There is an alarm system that notifies the manager
2. Mechanical ventilation is switched to natural ventilation / emergency power unit:



3. With mechanical feeding, the system switches to the following temporary, alternative feeding method:

PLANS OF BUILDING

1. A plan of the building(s) is readily available for the emergency services (kept visibly, outside the building)
2. This plan shows:
 - a. floor plans of the building and the pens etc.,
 - b. materials used,
 - c. evacuation routes for the animals, and
 - d. the location of:
 - i. access doors,
 - ii. fire extinguishing water point(s),
 - iii. gas, water, electricity,
 - iv. activities/substances that present a fire hazard, etc.
