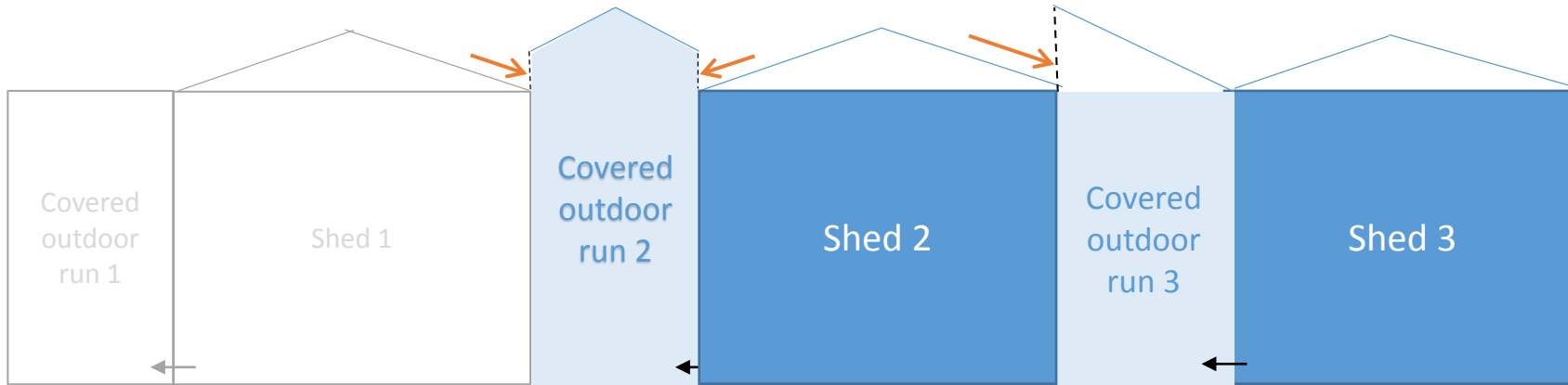


Plan of covered outdoor run between two existing buildings

A covered outdoor run between two buildings is only permitted:

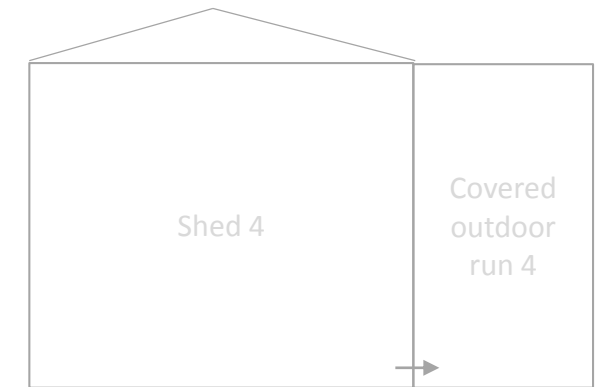
- for companies that wish to create a covered outdoor run between the existing buildings on an existing broiler or layer farm in order to be eligible for Better Life label 1 star.
- in the case of a completely new building, a covered outdoor run between two buildings is not permitted.
- if there is sufficient entry of daylight and fresh air

The roof of the covered outdoor run between two buildings has a daylight permeable surface of min. 3% of the floor area of the covered outdoor run.



On both long sides of the outdoor run there is an area of at least 1 metre high

On one long side of the outdoor run there is an area of at least 2 metres high



A house or shed without a separate covered outdoor run, but with daylight and air permeable material in part of the (side) walls (e.g. Louisiana-type house) is not eligible as a shed with a covered outdoor run.
